New Venture Showcase

The New Venture Showcase is a tradeshow event where each JHEC team has the opportunity to showcase their venture. On Thursday 11 December 2008 each team is required to showcase its venture for the judges, sponsors, faculty and business leaders. This event will run from 5.30pm until 7.30pm. You should staff your university entry's display and be prepared to answer questions from the attendees. The 60 second pitch competition will be held and judged as part of this event as will the Outstanding Showcase Display Award.

You are welcome to invite additional guests, however guests must register with payment no later than Monday 24 November 2008.

Teams may begin setting up from 3.30pm. Teams will be allocated their position in the room by the organisers and must remain in their allocated position.

Each team will be provided with:

- 1 x trestle table
- 1 x display board
- 2 x chairs per display
- 1 x power board

Please note:

Internet access is not available

Your team will need to provide:

All materials needed to erect your display; including stationary items (eg bluetack, pins, paper, sticky tape, velcro dots, double-sided tape etc)

If you are using your laptop to demonstrate, please make sure your battery is fully charged.

IMPORTANT NOTE - Those teams wishing to undertake additional activities as part of their display (eg prize draws) should provide details and request permission from the competition organisers well in advance of the event. This will allow time to be allocated in the running order and ensure sponsorship contracts are not breached.

60 Second Pitch Competition

Each team is required to nominate a team representative to participate in the 60 second pitch competition. One person from your team will be allocated a maximum of 1 minute to pitch your venture to the audience of judges, sponsors, faculty, business leaders and potential investors. No additional resources (props, other persons, AV etc) may be used. Failure to adhere to these guidelines may result in disqualification from the 60 second pitch competition.

The pitch will be scored using an electronic voting device. These devices will be randomly distributed amongst the guests in the room, and the pitch with the highest number of votes wins! The winner will receive a \$750 cash prize.

Outstanding Showcase Display Award

The Outstanding Showcase Display Award will be judged and announced at the New Venture Showcase by representatives from sponsoring organisation, BDO Kendalls. Showcase displays will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Presentation
 - Creative use of the allocated space and equipment provided
 - Clarity in visual presentation of product or venture
2. Sales & Marketing
 - Ability to verbally communicate the benefits of the product and venture
 - Ability to answer questions knowledgeably
 - Marketing collateral is visibly appealing and informative
 - All team members show enthusiasm and contribute to the promotion of the product or venture
